

Children and Chapel Safety Rules and Decorum

At St Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary, we recognize that one of our most sacred duties is the safety and well-being of all our children, both those who reside on campus and those who visit. In our continuing effort to provide our young members with a safe, faith-based environment, we ask that everyone adhere to the following policies:

- 1. Children are not permitted in any seminary building at anytime unless accompanied by a parent. No children under any circumstances are permitted in any dormitory or student common room.
- 2. Children under 12 are not permitted to leave church services, to go outside or visit the bathroom, without adult supervision as designated by his/her parent or guardian; teenagers (ages 12 or over) must use the "buddy system" when outside without adult supervision.
- 3. Children under 12 are not to be left in the chapel without adult supervision, as designated by his/her parent or guardian.
- 4. The church nave is not to be used as a playground at any time. Children should not be left to run around in the chapel. Unruly children should be taken outside.
- 5. Running or horseplay are not permitted in the chapel basement or church.
- 6. All children must wear shoes/shirts at all times.
- 7. All parents are responsible for "cleaning up" after their children.
- 8. With the exception of infants, food and drink are not permitted in the church at any time.

These procedures have been designed/developed to comply with all Safe Sanctuary and OCA guidelines, to meet insurance requirements, and to conform to applicable federal/state laws. For more detailed guidelines that apply to the children of students see the Student Handbook Policies and Procedures
